  - B. Olive Branch Petition reconciliation; drafted by Dickinson and other moderates; (Although war had begun, American position was still ambivalent)
    - King didn't accept
  - C. Thomas Paine *Common Sense* (150,000 copies sold in weeks)
  - D. Prospect of alliance with France looked good, while British were negotiating w/ German mercenaries (Hessians)
  - E. Richard Henry Lee calls for independence; TJ and others draft D.o.I.
